

Avoiding Potentially Harmful Online Resources

No matter how good your antivirus software is, it is always good practice to be vigilant online and avoid potentially harmful websites and online resources. Following is a list of such things to avoid, or at least approach with caution:

File sharing and torrent-tracking websites

These sites are the number one source of malicious software. While there are plenty of legitimate downloads to be found

on such sites, they should be approached with great caution. Sites which have user reviews and comments will give you a better idea of whether or not a download is safe, but in general, these types of websites should be avoided.

Suspicious email attachments

Email attachments, particularly those contained in spam emails, are another major source of malware. Never download attachments from unknown or unsolicited senders. Even if you know the sender, make sure you know what the attachment is before downloading it. If you are unsure, ask the sender to clarify.

Spam email

Aside from attachments containing malware, you should also ignore links in spam email. These will often direct you to malicious websites which may try to steal your personal or financial information.

Rogue software

Rogue software, often appearing in the form of fake antivirus or PC optimization software is another major source of concern. Fortunately, these are often quite easy to expose. If you are unsure about a certain program, a quick check on Google will usually yield the truth.

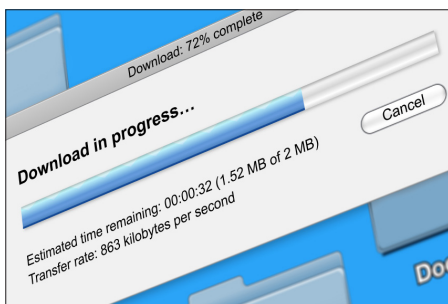
Online scams

Often arriving in spam email or in advertising banners on dubious websites, online scams are as rife as ever. As a general rule, if something seems too good to be true, then it probably is. Stay away.

Offline sources

Not all malware comes from the Internet. While you can generally trust any software that you buy in a legitimate shop, it is wise to be wary of things like USB flash drives containing unknown files and software, even if given to you by a friend.

Although practicing safe Web browsing is one thing, it is also highly advisable to keep your computer updated. Always install the latest updates for Windows and your programs when they are available. The same is true of hardware drivers. Such practice is good not only for computer security, but also for performance, reliability and more. **T**

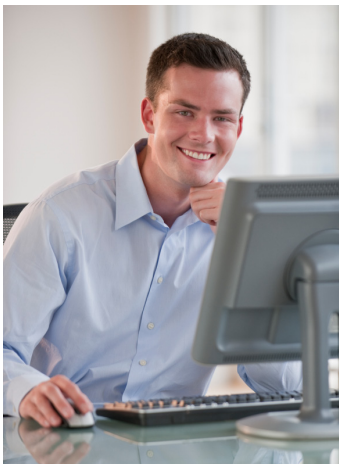
